






In 2014, we published 36,000 articles, that's almost 6 times as many articles as we delivered in 2008.

Our share of the market has **tripled** since 2008.


Our international influence

In 2014, over 113,000 authors from 85 countries published with us, and our **Editorial Board members** are truly international.





Each voucher code can be used to publish one paper free of charge.






Gold Open Access fees




RSC Open Access results so far...

- >620 Institutions qualify for Gold for Gold Voucher Codes
- In 2014
 - 2617 articles (96% increase from 2013 (1337))
 - from 341 institutions (199 in 2013)
 - in 39 different countries (34 in 2013)
- Institutions include:
 - University of Cambridge (UK)
 - University of California UCLA (US)
 - University of Queensland (Australia)
 - Indian Institute of Technology Bombay (India)
 - Osaka University (Japan)

Top ten countries publishing OA articles in 2014

Australia	130	5%

Italy	67	3%
Poland	64	2%



RSC Open Access Results in Czech Republic

In 2014

- 10 Institutions qualified for a total of 107 Gold for Gold Vouchers
- 53 out of 123 published articles have been made Open Access

In 2015

10 institutions hold a total of 110 Gold for Gold Vouchers



Benefits of Gold for Gold

Authors

- Easy solution to increasing pressure to publish OA
- Get more visibility for their research
- No need to deal with payments of OA articles

Librarians

- Great for relations with faculty
- Become more actively involved with OA
- A chance to experiment with this model








ChemSpider

ChemSpider is a free chemical structure database providing fast text and structure search access to **over 32 million structures** from hundreds of data sources.


